Membership in OPA is open to all serious professional and non-professional potters residing in Oregon and in the counties of Pacific, Lewis, Wahkiakum, Cowlitz, Clark, Skamania, and Klickitat in Southwest Washington.</p> <p>The membership year is from January 1st to December 31st. You may join at any time during the year, however dues are not prorated.</p> <p>Membership Benefits:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Six newsletters per year. ▪ Six general meetings per year. January, May, July, and November meetings are followed by a program. The September meeting occurs at our annual picnic. The March meeting includes a large potluck followed by booth selection for our annual show. ▪ Eligibility to participate in Ceramic Showcase, the largest all clay show is the USA. ▪ Group buys of expensive glaze materials such as tin, cobalt, and copper. ▪ Information sharing with many knowledgeable potters. ▪ Various OPA sponsored workshops and events. ▪ Access to the OPA Video/DVD library. ▪ The opportunity to promote yourself and your work on the OPA website, Flickr site, Facebook page and the OPA blog. 	<p style="text-align: center;">Instructions For Completing The Form</p> <p>General Member Information:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Enter your name, address, phone numbers, and all other applicable information. Note: If you leave the box blank any old data will be deleted. OPA does not sell or share address lists. 2. Check all boxes that apply to your primary work. 3. Choose either individual or collaborative membership. A collaborative membership is two individuals producing one body of work. The OPA Board reserves the right to evaluate any partnership application as valid and abiding by the definition of one body of work. <p>Membership Fees:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Choose new member, renewal, or returning member. 2. Choose how you want to receive your newsletter. Remember that receiving it by email saves OPA a lot of money and our savings is the reason our dues remain reasonable. 3. Fill in the dollar amount for each applicable membership category. The newsletter is included in the Regular Membership dues. 4. Newsletter Only Restrictions: If you live more than 100 miles from the Portland Metro area, you may choose the "newsletter only" category. Newsletter only recipients are not eligible for any other member benefits and may not apply for Ceramic Showcase. 5. \$5 of your regular membership dues goes to our Clay in Education program. If you would like to donate extra money to the program, enter the amount on the Clay in Education line. 6. If you would like to donate to the Craft Emergency Relief Fund, write in the amount you would like to donate. All CERF money collected by OPA is paid directly to CERF. 7. Calculate the total, and write it on the Membership Fees Total line. 8.
