Raku, a firing process developed in the Far East, has a deep relationship to the four basic elements: earth, air, water, and fire. It needs all of these in its creative process. It is in doing Raku that I have come to realize that I do not create alone but that One creates in and through me. I have a certain love relationship with my work while I am making it. I love the tactile nature of my art form, therefore, it is all hand built. I often think of the passage from Jeremiah 18:6 while I work: "Like clay in the hand of the potter, so are you in my hand."
