



OPA K-12 Artist in Residence Application - Fall 2022

Description of Artist in Residence Program

OPA's Artist in Residence program allows OPA members to partner with the K-12 community through Title I public school classrooms and after school programs. Artists in Residence are contract employees and develop their own curriculum tailored to the community they are working with. OPA provides training and support for classroom management practices and social emotional learning.

Compensation

OPA Artists in Residence receive a \$1200 stipend for their 40 hour residency, and can get reimbursed up to \$300 for materials.

Residence Timeline

Each residency's timeline is dependent upon the placement. All fall residencies will start in October to allow time for training and placement set up.

- September Training (Date to be determined)
- October: Start of residence
- April 29th: End of Year gathering and celebration at Ceramic Showcase, artist in residence will get to feature some of their students' work at OPA's 2023 Ceramic Showcase.
